

## BIKE EXCHANGE STAGE 5 BUS TRANSFER

Welcome to the bus transfer service for the 2017 Santos Tour Down Under, part of the UCI WorldTour. This transfer service has been designed in order for you to view the start and finish of stages 1-5.

Travellers will be collected and returned to Bus Stop F1, northern side Wakefield Street (Near Victoria Square. Opposite St Francis Xavier Cathedral), Adelaide.

NOTE: Please check in 15 minutes prior to departure time. You do not require tickets to travel. However, you will be required to quote your name and booking number at check-in. All passengers must be on the bus and ready to leave by the departure time. Late arrivals may not be able to be accommodated. Bookings on the day will not be accepted.

#### SATURDAY 21 JANUARY 2017 - MCLAREN VALE TO WILLUNGA TOWNSHIP

Please make your own way to **Bus Stop F1, northern side Wakefield Street (Near Victoria Square. Opposite St Francis Xavier Cathedral), Adelaide.**

- 0830** Check in at Bus Stop F1, Wakefield Street, Adelaide
- 0900** Depart Adelaide for McLaren Vale
- 1000** Arrive McLaren Vale
- 1110** Race start
- 1130** Depart McLaren Vale for Willunga Township
- 1145** Arrive Willunga Township

Bike Exchange Stage 5 is a favourite for the spectators and heralded as the Queen Stage of the Santos Tour Down Under. The day starts in McLaren Vale, famous for its winemaking. The town is always in party mode during the race, with the peloton headed for the iconic Willunga Hill. Fans flock to the side of the road to cheer on their heroes in what is often the deciding stage of the Santos Tour Down Under.

- 1530** Depart Willunga Township for Adelaide
- 1715** Estimated arrival in Adelaide
