Brief Description	The operations, logistics and transport team are responsible for providing logistical and transport services before, during and after the event. This team assists in: the pick up and delivery of materials, packing event kits, the set-up and pack down of event sites such as the registration marquee, start locations, finish location, and refreshment stations. This team is responsible for the coordination of event vehicles including the collection and transportation of vehicles to various event sites, and may assist in the transport of event drivers. Operations and Transport Assistants are required to hold a valid drivers license eligible in Australia.
Key Responsibilities	 Under the direction of the Warehouse Manager, the Operations & Transport Assistant will undertake logistical tasks which may include: Accepting deliveries Stocktaking and allocating event stock to the various event vehicles and locations Collecting event vehicles and trailers Distributing stock and vehicles to event locations Stocktaking and packing of event stock at the conclusion of the event Transport drivers and event staff to various event locations as required
