TASKS

- Proactively distribute Santos Tour Down Under programs and promotional materials to spectators at start and finish locations
- Welcome and assist event visitors by providing event information, promoting Tour Down Under Fan Zone activities and South Australian tourism experiences, and supporting a positive spectator experience
- Assist with the safe presentation, positioning and removal of the official start line ribbon in accordance with event protocols and Event Staff directions
- Assist with the collection and escorting of riders from the team support parking area to the podium presentation tent
- Coordinate the packing and loading of the event vehicle with programs and promotional material prior to leaving the Event Office each day
- Any other tasks as requested by Assistant Event Manager or team leader

The Onsite Host Team Leader leads and coordinates Onsite Host operations at start and finish locations ensuring all activities are delivered safely, efficiently and in line with event requirements.

*Please note this position involves standing and/or walking around the stage start and finish locations for the majority of the shift.

*Shift finish times are dependent on travel times back from the finish location and are anticipated times only.

LOCATION & TRANSPORT

The shifts will be located at the various location's dependant on the stage location. You will need to check in at the Santos Tour Down Under Head Office, located in the Amora Hotel Adelaide (233 Victoria Square) on Level 1.

Please note, there are no provisions within the Tour Village for private vehicles to be parked.

Volunteers are required to make their own arrangements to and from Adelaide CBD, but transport will be provided to and from the stages.

MEALS

Water will be available at all times; please ensure you bring a reusable water bottle to refill.

A light meal will be provided if the shift is over 5 hours in duration.

Volunteers are welcome to bring snacks if they feel they require something to eat during the shift.

UNIFORM

Official event t-shirt (provided at volunteer briefing), neat and tidy black/denim pants or knee length shorts/skirt, closed toed comfortable footwear.

A hat and sunscreen will be provided should work be required to be undertaken outdoors.
