NATURE OF EMPLOYMENT

Honorarium role. Honorarium roles will receive a daily allowance, which will be paid upon receiving a tax invoice.

REPORTS TO

Traffic Logistics Coordinator, Ian Forster / Police Commander, Chief Superintendent

TASKS

As an official tour driver of the Santos Tour Down Under, this role involves the following;

- Must have previous race convoy experience (national level at minimum)
- Must have a valid unrestricted motorcycle licence.
- Hold a current UCI or an AusCycling compliant licence (a non-riding licence is accepted and can be obtained here: [Non-Riding Membership | AusCycling | AusCycling](#))
- Obtain a UCI ID through the [UCI ID Request Form](#)
- Be present at the Tour Village on race day 40mins prior to tour convoy departure. Exact times of departure will be provided closer to event.
- Ensuring the moto is cleaned and refuelled each day before returning daily.
- Must obey the orders and directions always given by Race Regulator and Commissaires.
- Should, as much as possible, understand the route. Or at least carefully have read the route guide before the start to be more

aware and help anticipate danger zones, eg. feed zone, tunnels, level crossings, critical points in the race, etc.

- The locations in which the yellow flags are utilised will be identified in advance and tasks allocated as necessary. You will need to assist with tasks such as, leading the race, protecting the riders, assisting with direction changes, blocking/marshalling side roads and intersections etc.
- Each and every time overtaking any vehicle, motorbike or cyclist please use the horn for warning. This is crucial in the safety of the race convoy. Take extreme care when passing the peloton and riders and only do so when safe.
- **Note:** A detailed route map, departure schedule and yellow flag locations will be supplied by the Tour Down Under team to help facilitate with getting to start and finish line location. Police escort will also be provided.
- The Santos Tour Down Under will provide motorbikes during the event
