- Located at the finish line, help with unloading equipment from vehicles
- Assist photo finish and transponder contractors with the installation and testing of high-speed photo finish and transponder timing equipment
- Activate high speed timing systems as the race leaders approach the finish line timing contractors will train the timing assistants how to complete the task
- Assist with the pack down of timing equipment back onto road cases, rolling up cables and packing vehicles
