- Assistance with the back of house (BOH) preparations for the winner's presentations
- Packing the event vehicle with programs and promotional material prior to leaving
- Any other tasks as requested by event coordinator or team leader

*Please note this position involves standing and/or walking around the stage start and finish locations for the majority of the shift.
