## ROLE DESCRIPTION

As a volunteer Course Traffic Marshal you can legally perform traffic duties to assist SAPOL in implementing rolling road closures to permit the Santos Tour Down Under riders and support vehicles to travel safely on South Australian roads. Course Traffic Marshals are also used to identify potential hazards such as roundabouts and traffic islands to the approaching riders along the race route. The role of Course Traffic Marshals is to assist with the management of people and vehicles, volunteers are NOT to try and physically stop any person or motorist who disobeys their directions.

Marshals will be required to undertake a training session with a SAPOL representative and Traffic Logistics Coordinator prior to undertaking this role.

Marshals will be required to travel to a central pickup/drop off point in the CBD and then travel via arranged transport to the designated marshal position(s) on course. Following the stage, volunteers will be returned to the central pickup/drop off point in the CBD.

**NOTE: This position involves standing for the full duration of the listed roster times.**

## SHIFT DATES and TIMES

Course Traffic Marshals will be required to be available on at least five stages across the Santos Tour Down Under & Santos Women's Tour Down Under.

Course Traffic Marshals may have multiple points to control on any given day and the designated transport driver will ensure Traffic Marshals get to their designated points in time for each road closure. Marshals may be in a given location on their own and at other times will have another marshal positioned with them.

**Sunday 23 January 2022** Various locations along the Tanunda to Williamstown race route, between 0800 - 1500

**Monday 24 January 2022** Various locations along the McLaren Vale to McLaren Flat race route, between 0800 - 1500

**Tuesday 25 January 2022** Various locations along the Lobethal race route, between 0800 – 1500

**Thursday 27 January 2022** Various locations along the Stirling to Lobethal race route, between 0800 – 1500

**Friday 28 January 2022** Various locations along the Mt Lofty to Woodside race route, between 0800 – 1500

**Saturday 29 January 2022** Various locations along the McLaren Vale to Willunga Hill race route, between 0800 - 1500

Water will be available, and lunch will be provided as the shift is over 5 hours in duration. Volunteers are welcome to bring snacks if they feel they require something else to eat during the shift.

## LOCATION/TRANSPORT

This position will meet at the City of Adelaide Festival Village, located at Victoria Park / Pakapakanthi (Park 16). Volunteers are required to make own arrangements to and from each shift.

Please note there are no provisions within the Tour Village for private vehicles to be parked.

Volunteers are required to make their own arrangements to and from the CBD pickup / drop off location for each shift.

Please wear the provided shirt / reflective vest and hat for the duration of your shift in addition to maintaining a neat and clean appearance and closed toed shoes.
