## **ROLE DESCRIPTION**

- Ability to take direction and follow instructions from event staff, in particular the PR Managers and Media Managers
- Correspondence (verbal and electronic) with media and the public
- Great computer skills and confident in using a variety of digital platforms
- The ability to demonstrate a flexible mindset when requests change at a moment's notice

- Driving event vehicles where applicable (and if able to do so in line with insurance requirements)
- Research
- Assisting PR staff with press conferences, live TV news, radio, newspaper, and other media interviews in the Media Centre
