TASKS

- Assist with on time departure of the race peloton & official vehicles
- Receive & store drink deliveries
- Restocking team fridges
- Assistance maintaining vehicle key register
- General cleaning of the village marquee, including vacuuming & emptying bins
- Moving and positioning of equipment as directed
- Pick up or delivery of wheels, tyres, or vehicles to service agents for repairs
- Movement of pedestrian fencing in preparation for village opening and closing
- Follow up with TDU staff on requests from teams
- Any other jobs as required

*Please note, some of the tasks require heavy lifting. If you feel a task is beyond your capability, please advise your supervisor before attempting that task. This role requires being on your feet for the duration of the shift.

LOCATION & TRANSPORT

The shifts will be located at the Tour Village, Victoria Square (South). You will need to check in at the Site Office for your shifts.

MEALS
