TASKS

- Monitor the designated area at the Start Line / Finish Line to ensure patrons and staff are abiding by the Event's COVID rules
- Monitor the signage and other infrastructure (such as hygiene material) set up to provide a COVID Safe area, adjust them if they are not working effectively, and/or communicate to the operations team that something needs adjusting
- Promote and take practical steps to ensure patrons are complying with the 1.5 metre physical distancing rule
- COVID Marshals have no formal authority. Where patrons are believed to be breaching COVID directions and have not followed the advice provided by the COVID Marshal, the COVID Marshal should report to the Head COVID Marshal – Start / Finish Line
- Record any COVID issues identified and actioned, including outcomes
- Other tasks as required

*This position involves standing and or walking around for portions of the shift

Saturday 29 January 2022 Various locations along the McLaren Vale to Willunga Hill race route, between 0800 - 1500
